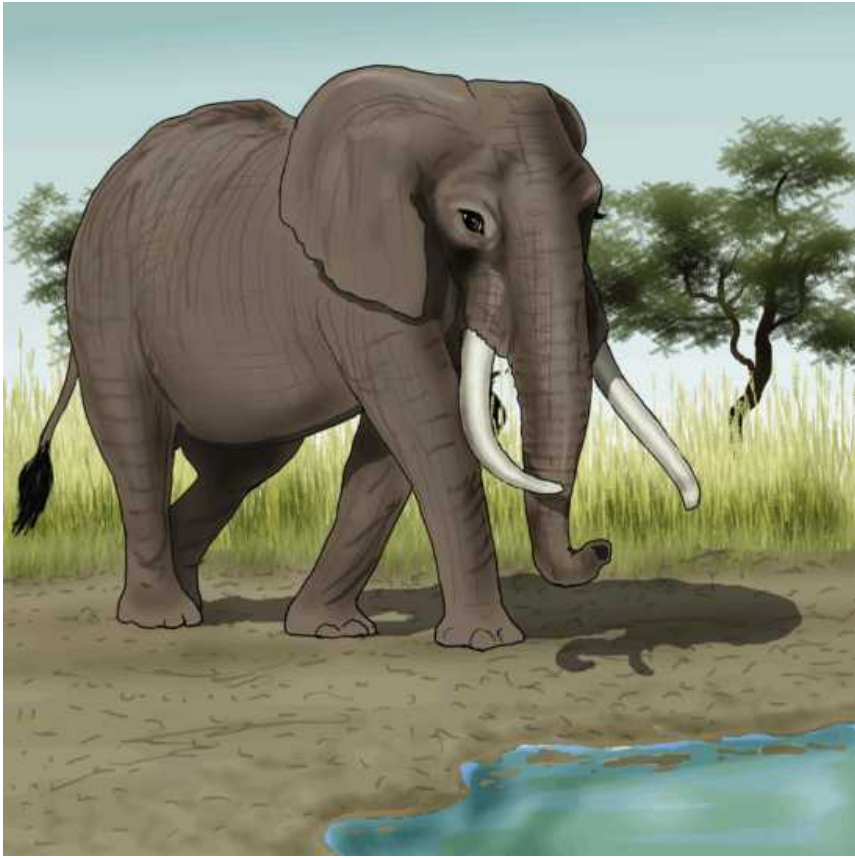

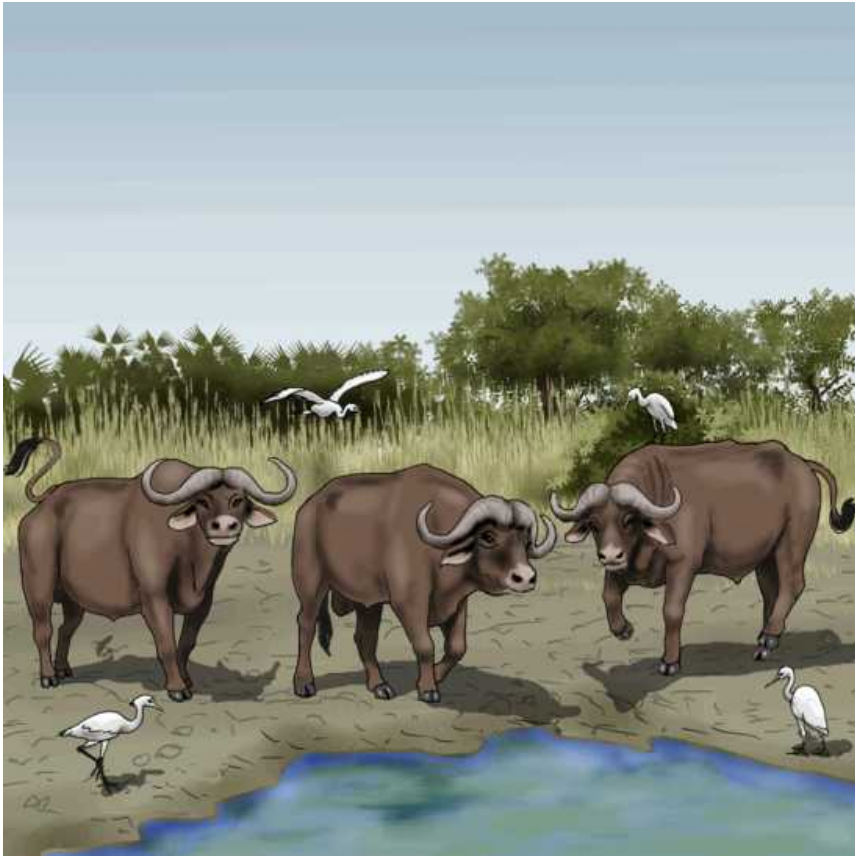




One elephant is going to drink water.



Two giraffes are going to drink water.



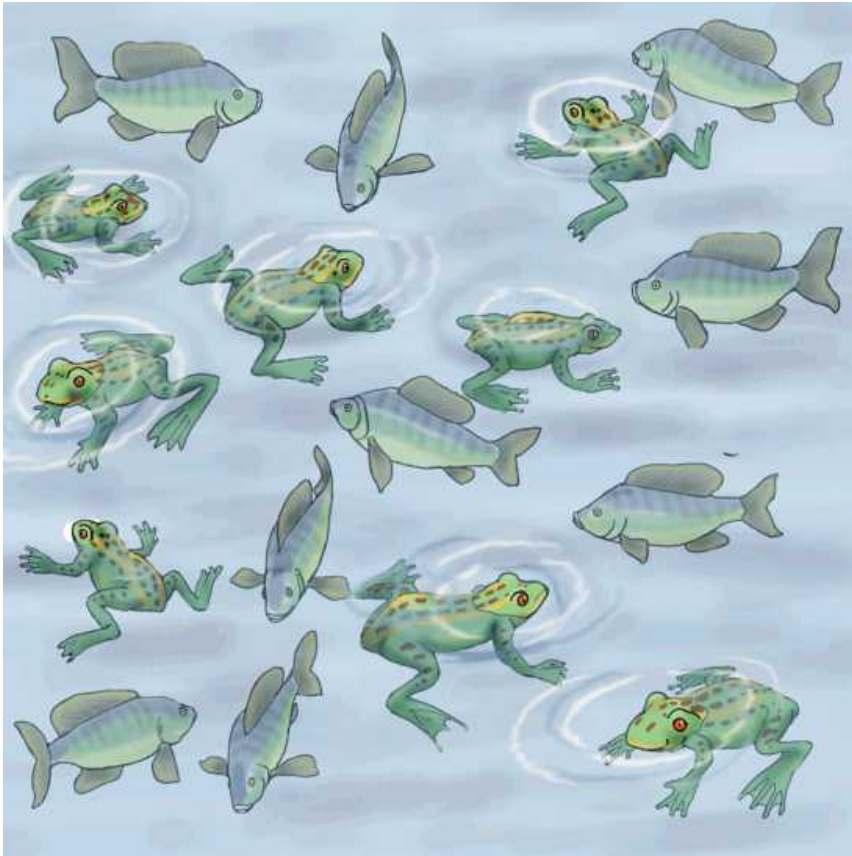
Three buffaloes and four birds are also going to drink water.
