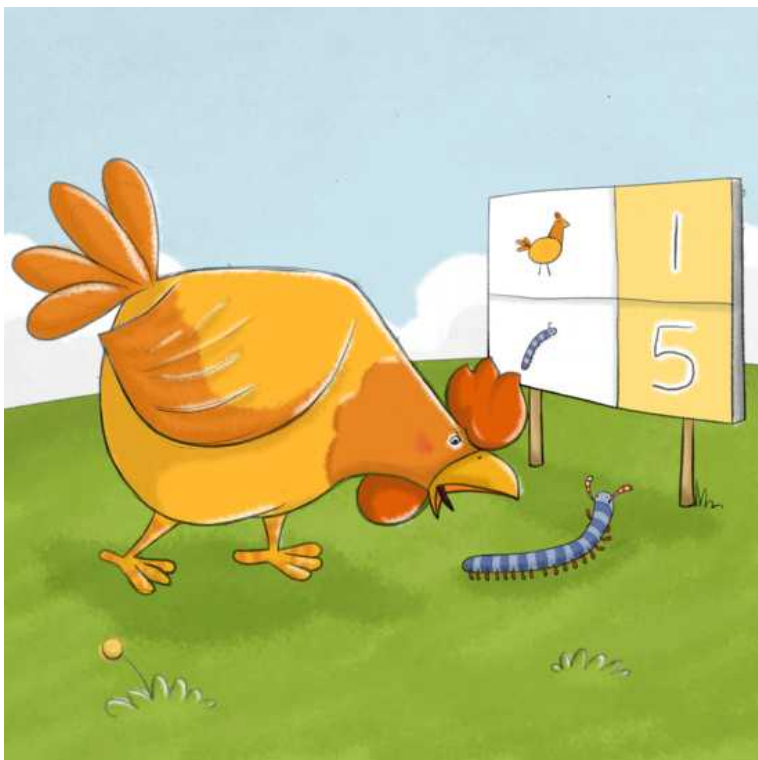
Millipede kicked the ball and scored. Millipede
