

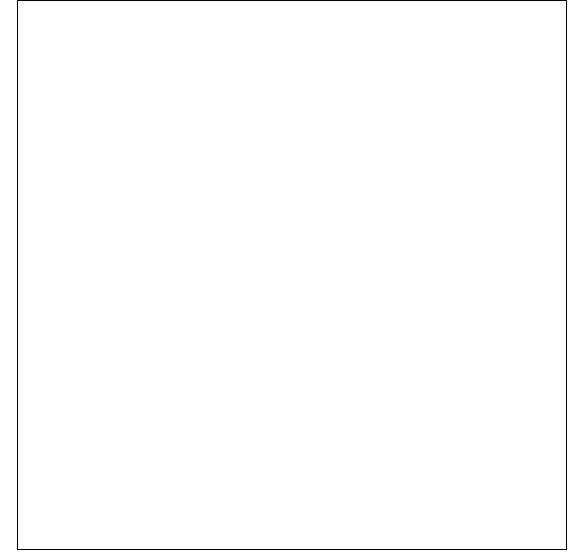
One day, Rabbit was walking by the


