Eight-year-old Juma, sitting on a tree trunk shouted, "I can help with cleaning up."

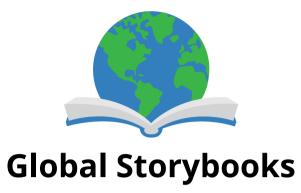
Namyo umo asosa ati, "Bana mayo kuti twabombela pamo ukulima ifyakulya."
