






Isang araw, pasan ni Tom ang isang kahon ng saging.




Dala-dala niya ito sa palengke para itinda.

Namimili ng prutas ang mga tao sa iba.




Pero walang bumibili kay Tom. Mas gusto nila ang mga babaeng tindera.






"Dito sa atin, babae lang ang naglalako," sabi nila.

Pero hindi si Tom sumuko. "Bili na kayo ng saging! Matamis na saging kayo riyan!" sigaw niya.






May isang aleng lumapit kay Tom. Dinampot ang isang piling at matagal na tiningnan ang saging.




At saka bumili kay Tom.
